
Humber Acute Services Review – Update

The Review Steering Group has today published an <u>Issues Paper</u> to support public, patient and staff engagement in the work of the review. The purpose of this document is to set out some of the big challenges the NHS and other health and care bodies in the Humber area are facing. It describes some of the work that NHS bodies, local Councils and other health and care organisations are doing in partnership to help improve local heath and care services.
