## Yorkshire Ambulance Service – Working with the VCSE Sector

During the meeting we welcomed representatives from Yorkshire Ambulance Service (YAS) who are beginning to develop a new strategic plan. The VCSE Collaborative discussed community engagement opportunities and highlighted the work of Healthwatch across Humber and North Yorkshire to support the development of the strategy. The strategy will also include a focus on volunteering and appropriate volunteering roles within the Ambulance Service and explore how YAS can work with the VCSE sector going forward. We'll share engagement opportunities with the sector as soon as they are available.

## Volunteers at the Heart of the System update

The Volunteers at the Heart of the System workstream continues. The initial findings report has been circulated and is available to <u>download here</u>. The programme of work to scope volunteering practices will continue as the recommendations are implemented across the system. The Collaborative has also now recruited a Strategic Volunteer Lead role who will start working on the programme in November.

#### **Useful definitions:**

**Integrated Care Systems (ICSs)** - are partnerships that bring together providers and commissioners of NHS services across a geographical area with local authorities and other local partners to collectively plan health and care services to meet the needs of their population.

**Integrated Care Board (ICB)** - an organisation with responsibility for NHS functions and budgets for the ICS.

**Integrated Care Partnership (ICP)** - a statutory committee of the ICB bringing together all system partners to produce a health and care strategy.

**Place-based** / **At place** - Refers to the geographical locations across Humber and North Yorkshire.
