

## North Yorkshire and York Places – Guidance on how to obtain urgently required End of Life medicines

Any community pharmacy service can be used to order / obtain end of life drugs in advance (anticipatory drugs) where these are not urgent or immediately required.

Where End of Life drugs are required urgently – access a pharmacy participating in the emergency palliative care drugs in community pharmacy scheme as these are commissioned to stock emergency palliative care drugs:

- North Yorkshire Place participating pharmacies: emergency palliative care drugs in community pharmacy scheme
- York Place participating pharmacies: emergency palliative care drugs in community pharmacy scheme
- Other pharmacies may stock palliative care drugs as part of the Pharmacy Quality Scheme (PQS) palliative and end of life care. In hours: Access a community pharmacy (CP) signed up to deliver the emergency palliative care drugs in CP scheme as these are commissioned to stock emergency palliative care drugs (links above) or a dispensing GP practice; Electronic or paper FP10 . <u>Stock cannot always be guaranteed so contact CP or dispensing GP</u> practice in advance to confirm medicine availability

If Option 1 is not possible, contact another local CP. If prescription is issued in hours but local CP has closed unexpectedly, try another CP that can provide EoL drugs (see links above). If local pharmacies are closed but OOH GP service is operational, contact local OOH GP service to handover care. OOH GP – book patient in, clinical care taken over by OOH clinician and supply enabled by patient specific direction or prescription.

In hours or OOH - if usual routes have been exhausted and no stock is available, the local hospital pharmacy can be contacted for supply. This is a last resort. Any hospital requests must be reported to the NY&Y Medicines Management Team as soon as is practical via hnyicb-ny.rxline@nhs.net so that stock situations can be urgently reviewed.

- *Carer/relative, neighbour, friend*
- Community pharmacy delivery service (discretionary)
- GP dispensing practice staff
- Community Nursing service eq Distrct Nurse; Palliative care team; Macmillan Nurse; Marie Curie

Existing guidance and governance arrangements regarding medicines delivery apply and should be in place.
