Catterick Integrated Care Centre

A unique integrated care centre, bringing a range of health and social care services together under one roof in a purpose-built facility.

A joint collaboration, and first of its kind, between the National Health Service (NHS) and Ministry of Defence (MOD).

The new facility has been designed to meet Net Zero Carbon (NZC) standards and achieve a DREAM Excellent rating.



Timeline of works

March 2024: Sub-structure work began on site and finished in October 2024.

May 2024: The steel arrived on site and began to be erected, this process finished in September 2024.

August 2024: The roofing of the building began and is due to finish in December 2024.

September 2024: Internal fitout - this makes any interior space suitable for use looking at electrical, mechanical and plumbing work.

October 2024: Window fitting will start this month, due to finish in January 2025. Brickwork and cladding gets underway and this is due to finish in July 2025.

July 2025: Facade completion (the outside or external faces of a building).

Build due to complete in Spring 2026.
