Public Engagement – Spring Roadshow Events June 2024

Summary

Introduction

The Catterick Integrated Care Campus (CICC) is a unique project, bringing a range of health and social care services together under one roof in a purpose-built facility.

This collaboration between the NHS and the Ministry of Defence (MOD) is a first of its kind, and since 2015 the two organisations have been working together with a joint vision and purpose, to

help improve the range of health and care services for people living in Catterick Garrison and the wider Richmondshire area.

The new facility aims to give all residents of Richmondshire access to the right care, at the right time, in the right setting, delivered by the right professionals to enhance their wellbeing and independence and improve their overall quality of life.

Engagement Aims and Objectives

It has been some time since the Catterick Integrated Care Campus (CICC) project team undertook any engagement with the local population.

Work on-site is now well underway, and the shape of the new building is beginning to emerge as the steel frame continues to be erected over the coming months.

To ensure that the residents are kept fully informed of progress, key NHS and MOD partners came together to plan and deliver a series of roadshow events across the local area during May 2024 with the aims of:

- Providing information, raising awareness, and continuing conversations around the services going into the CICC, the progress of the build, and projected timescales.
- Providing opportunities for people to ask questions, share concerns or provide feedback.
- Providing opportunities for people to sign up to a CICC stakeholder distribution list so they can receive further information and involvement opportunities in the future.



Joined Up Approach

The CICC also worked closely with colleagues from the Local Authority aligned to the Levelling Up Project on Shute Road to jointly deliver the roadshow events. The purpose of this collaboration was to promote a positive unified message of the regeneration opportunities happening in Catterick, as both projects have similar timescales.

Engagement Process/Approach

Promotional work leading up to the roadshow events consisted of:

- A press release (issued on May 20th, 2024. See **Appendix 1**)
- Posters displayed on notice boards in popular community locations across the local area.
- Invitation emails to local stakeholders (including town councils, NHS colleagues, VCSE, MOD personnel, GP practices).

The roadshow events were held across 7 high-footfall locations in Catterick, Richmond, and Colburn. A full list of places visited can be found in the table below.

Across all the roadshow events, we spoke to 213 people in total. A full breakdown can be found in **Appendix 2**. We were joined at all the events by a representative from <u>Tilbury Douglas</u>.

Our stand consisted of three large print A0 posters, providing accurate and up-to-date information on; the services that may be provided within the CICC, updated imagery of the outside of the building, and a high-level building timeline. These can be found in **Appendix 3**

In addition, we designed and handed out folded A5 information leaflets. These replicated the information displayed on the larger boards but allowed people to take the information away with them.

The leaflets also contained contact details and a QR code that people could scan to find out more and sign up to the newsletter distribution list (mentioned above in the engagement aims). Appendix 1 – Press Release

Catterick Garrison: major regeneration schemes showcased.

People living in Catterick and the wider Richmondshire area are being invited to attend drop-in events where two major regeneration projects will be showcased.

In Catterick Garrison, work is underway to build a flagship 'integrated care campus', funded by the NHS and Ministry of Defence (MOD), which will provide medical and care services for military personnel and their families, as well as the civilian population in Catterick and wider Richmondshire area. <u>Click here</u> for more information about the Catterick Integrated Care Campus project.

At the same time, plans to regenerate Catterick Town Centre with £19 million secured through the Government's Levelling Up fund, together with investment from North Yorkshire Council and the MOD are beginning to take shape.

The project will see a new town square on Shute Road, extra retail and commercial premises, improved pedestrian access, together with a new community building, improved play areas, footpaths, and cycle routes. There's more information on the North Yorkshire Council website.

This month's informal drop-in events, organised by North Yorkshire Council, the MOD, and NHS are aimed at giving people the opportunity to see more detailed plans for the two schemes, talk to those involved and ask any questions. The events are on:-

NHS Humber and North Yorkshire Integrated Care Board's (ICB) Deputy Place Director, North Yorkshire, Lisa Pope, said: "The Catterick Integrated Care Campus has been almost 10 years in the making, but with construction work under way, our vision is inching ever closer to becoming reality. Together with our partners from the MOD, NHS Property Services and local authority, we're looking forward to seeing people at the public drop-in events and explaining more about what the integrated care campus will bring to Catterick and the wider Richmondshire community."

North Yorkshire Council leader, Cllr Carl Les, said: "Our exciting project to transform the centre of Catterick Garrison and greatly improve amenities for the local community is starting to take shape with building working beginning this summer. It will benefit everyone living and working in communities around the garrison, as well as the service personnel and their families who are stationed at Catterick and who play a vital role in the life of our county."

The steel arrives on site and begins to be erected, this process will finish in November 2024.

July 2024

Sub-structure work begins on site and is due to finish in November 2024.

August 2024

The roofing of the building will begin and is due to finish in July 2025.

September 2024

Internal fitout - This makes any interior space suitable for use looking at electrical, mechanical and plumbing work.

October 2024

Window fitting due to finish in January 2025.

Brickwork and cladding underway and due to finish in July 2025.

July 2025

Facade completion (the outside or all of the external faces of a building).

Spring 2026: End of construction
