What's been happening on site?

- Internal walls have started throughout the building.
- The mechanical and electrical works have commenced on all floors.
- The roof sheeting is 70% complete and works to the external cladding and windows is well under way.
- Internal blockwork walls have been formed.
- On the externals, work has started with the south car park and drainage around the site.
