



## East Riding Integrated Neighbourhood Teams (INTs)

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### Driffield

**Neighbourhood:** The Driffield INT encompasses the whole Town of Driffield and surrounding villages, supporting all of the residents in the area.

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**Meetings:** The INT usually meets in-person on a monthly basis at The Parks Surgery, Driffield. Project specific groups also meet as and when required. Current project specific groups: Pain Service, Care Homes.

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**Approaches:** Set up in March 2023 as an East Riding pilot INT, Driffield INT have developed a successful process. Data is used to identify areas of concern and system partners provide insight of local current issues. The combined intelligence guides which cohorts are selected. Cohort-specific Multi-Disciplinary Teams (MDTs) support individuals with complex needs and provide themes to develop scalable solutions/ projects.

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#### Cohorts Supported to Date:

- Children frequent attenders – ‘When should I Worry’ project and Alfred Bean Respiratory Hub.
  - Chronic pain – Ongoing work to develop improvements to chronic pain service.
  - Current project: Care homes – Six areas of focus E.g. connecting with system partners through a workshop training day.
  - Current project: Support to Foodbank through MDTs and linking services.
  - Current project: 0-8yr olds neurodivergent/ mental health provision.
