



East Riding Integrated Neighbourhood Teams (INTs)

Hornsea and Leven

Neighbourhood: The Hornsea and Leven INT encompasses the town of Hornsea, Leven, Beeford and all surrounding villages. It supports all of the residents that are registered at Eastgate Medical Group and Leven & Beeford Medical Practice.

Meetings: The INT usually meets in-person (Teams is available) on a 6 weekly basis at Eastgate Medical Group, Hornsea.

Approaches: Set up initially in 2023 as an Inequalities Group and then evolving into the current INT from 8th August 2024. Using local knowledge and collected data to confirm areas of focus, with the aim of:

- Streamlining access to care and advice to meet the needs of infrequent users of health care services
 - Providing more proactive, personalised and multi-disciplinary care for people with more complex needs
 - Helping people to stay well for longer, through a joined-up approach to prevention

Cohorts Supported to Date:

- Piloting rapid diagnostic service and new developments – ongoing with Hull University Teaching Hospitals NHS Trust radiology team
 - Lung health check and associated cardiovascular screening (Eastgate Medical Group)
 - Breast screening access
 - Bowel screening non-responders project (Eastgate Medical Group)
 - Serious mental illness care home cancer screening project
 - Dementia care – pre and post ‘official’ diagnosis, signposting for family and patients
 - Rural / agricultural health inequalities, targeting 3 elements:
 - Cardiovascular disease – Biggest health impact “*working*” age males, particularly smokers
 - Mental health - *RABI’s Big Farming Survey conducted in 2021 has revealed that 36% of farmers in the UK are probably or possibly depressed, while 47% are constantly struggling with anxiety*
 - Prostate cancer – The area that is asked about the most in this patient group
