



East Riding Integrated Neighbourhood Teams (INTs)

River and Wolds

Neighbourhood: The River and Wolds INT encompasses Brough, Hessle, South Cave, Holme and Spalding Moor and Bubwith Practice areas.

Meetings: The INT usually meets in-person on a bi-monthly basis at Brough Surgery.

Approaches: Set up in 2024, we are a newly formed INT looking to identify needs across our Primary Care Network area. We are looking at working with a number of VCSE groups through the work our Social Prescribers are undertaking in the community. We have been working with the Business Intelligence team to develop a Population Health Intelligence Pack for our Primary Care Network/ INT.

Cohorts Supported to Date:

- Stroke Patients – Our Social Prescribers have been working with recent stroke patients to identify any clinical and social needs following diagnosis. We have been liaising with the stroke service to see how we can support patient following diagnosis and prior to being seen in the stroke service.
 - Community Groups Database – A project to look at the activities taking place in the community and working with VCSE partner to signpost suitable patients. A list of groups known in the area is being collated and groups are being visited to find out what they have to offer, confirming contact details to help with onward patient referrals into the groups.
 - Communication with Community Services – A project to improve the messaging with other SystemOne users in community services, to develop a more streamlined process for two-way communication.
